#### Compass Sport Cup'00 Final, Ilkley Moor, 18th June

First of all, I'd like to say a big thank you to everyone who ran at Wakerley. Facing last year's winners in the first round looked like it would be a tough challenge. However, on the day, NOC members ran their socks (muddy?) off to win the heat with a healthy margin over WCH (2nd), DVO (3rd), OD, LEI, HOC, NOR and WAOC. Particular thanks go to those of you who travelled long distances to support your club. [I am in possession of a course B map - if it's yours please call or email me and I'll arrange to get it to you.]

The grand final will take place on I kley Moor on June 18th, with parking/assembly at I kley Grammar School. I hope that you will be able to join the NOC team in our competition against SYO, SLOW, MDOC and BOK. This time there will not be an opportunity to enter on the day, so please get your entries to me well in advance of the closing date, so that I have time to organise the club entry. We will be using pre-marked bagged maps and Sport I dent electronic punching. Don't forget to send me both your BOF and card numbers. If you don't send a sport ident number then add 50p to your entry fee to cover the hire charge. Fees are £5/£2 (junior rate for students), please make cheques payable to NOC and ensure that they arrive at 29 Mason Rd, I keston, DE7 9JP by 15th May (NB ATRE have changed the closing date from that listed in the BOF fixtures). Starts will be from 11am to 1pm (with some starts available 1-2pm for parents to have split times), don't forget to include your preferred start block and course with your entry. I've booked a 49 seater coach, so please tell me whether you would like to reserve a place. Cost will be around £7 for adults and £4 for juniors payable on the day. We will meet at West Bridgford Library opposite the Co-op for a 7.30 am departure and should be back by 7pm at the latest. The courses on offer are the same as before,

A - Open, B - Open 20-/35+, C - Open 18-/45+, D - W Open,

E - W45 + /M60 +, F - W18 - /M16 - and G - W14 - /M14 -.

There will also be a yellow course for non-competitive people.

#### Harvester Relays

If you think JK and BOC relays are a little tame, then you'll be looking forward to this year's Harvester Trophy Relay which will take place near Rochdale on the 8th/9th July. I took part last year for the first time and can thoroughly recommend this truly surreal experience! It's also a very easy way to convince friends and colleagues that you and your fellow orienteers are indeed completely mad!

Watergrove reservoir is the 'stage' of a huge natural amphitheatre, stretching over a kilometre to the west, north and east. The organisers envisage some very interesting patterns of competitor lights all night long and head-to head racing with excellent spectator facilities in the later stages of the race. It is primarily fast open moorland with very few tussocks and hardly any bracken. There are complex land forms, tricky contour detail, many decrepit walls, streams, marshes and deep re-entrants but virtually no paths. There are two races - A - seven legs (5 night/2 day, mix of TD 4 and 5, distance 5 - 12 km) and B - five legs (4 night/1 day, mix of TD 3, 4 and 5, distance 4 - 7 km). Entry fees are £8/£4, Sport I dent will be used - please send your card number or indicate if you'll need to hire a card - and send cheques (payable to NOC) to me by 1st June. NB. if you're entering more than one event, it would make my accounting easier if you sent separate cheques.
