Explore the Parks series is showing a loss at present but we are awaiting a grant from Nottingham City Council which should reverse the reported loss.

It was pointed out that our cash asset has been the same for the last five years. This is because there is little need for cash transactions now. Does this now contain money that is no longer in circulation after the introduction of the new £5, £1 and £10? Treasurer to check this.

# 7. Adoption of Rule Changes

Rule Change 1

This change is to enable the club to comply with BOF rules and regulations and is the same as has been adopted by EMOA

Clause 2: Objectives

#### Current wording

The objective of the club shall be to further the development of, and participation in, the sport of orienteering.

#### Proposed rule change

The objective of the club shall be to further the development of, and participation in, the sport of orienteering. The club (NOC) agrees to adopt the up to date British Orienteering Policies, Procedures, Rules and Regulations as published on the British Orienteering website.

All individuals involved in orienteering through the club, in any capacity, are deemed to have assented to and abide by the British Orienteering Policies, Procedures, Rules and Regulations as published on the British Orienteering website. Both the club and its members agree to abide by the final outcome of any disciplinary and appeal proceedings.

Rule Change 2

This has become necessary due to the lack of volunteers coming forward to serve on the committee.

Clause 4 Committee Membership

### Paragraph 10 Current wording

No person may hold the same office for more than three years consecutively. They will however be able to stand for a different office. Persons co-opted into an office at or before the second committee meeting following the AGM will be considered to have been elected at that AGM.

### Proposed rule change

No person may hold the same office for more than three years consecutively. They will however be able to stand for a different office. In the event of there being no candidates for committee positions, existing post holders who have reached the end of their duration in office may be invited to have that period extended. Persons co-opted into an office at or before the second committee meeting following an AGM will be considered to have been elected at that AGM.

### 8. Election of Officers

There were no nominations for a Volunteer co-ordinator.

Andrew Ridgway has been doing this role and is willing to continue. His role as Fixtures secretary is closely linked with the volunteer co-ordinator role although the two roles can be done by two people.

The Chairman and the Fixtures Secretary have come to the end of their three year tenure but are willing to continue.

Andrew Llewellyn is standing down as team captain after a successful term in office. He will continue until his replacement Mick Lucking is able to take over in January 2018.

# 9. Open Forum

There was a long discussion on how to attract and keep new members as this is the only way we can get more volunteers.

- If we can attract families then this helps to boost our numbers. Hilary is putting on another 'Explore the Parks' series next year. Hilary is also putting four fun, sociable activities on at Rushcliffe during the winter.
- Getting keen teachers to encourage orienteering in schools. This has been key in the past in helping to boost our numbers.
- Can we attract some of the student population from the universities? This works best if we have a keen orienteer as a student. We may be able to target freshers week to get some intertest.
