2 Items for Discussion

a) Participant Survey - Skype with Natalie Weir

The survey by BOF was carried out at three Explore the Parks events in the summer. The comments from participants were positive, especially the warm welcome and help given to newcomers to the events. 18% of respondents were at their first event and distances travelled were between one and five miles.

There was a long discussion on how we can use such events to increase participation in 'normal' events. Themes discussed included:

- What sort of people are we targeting? e.g. Families with children (of any age or those with children who can learn to read a map), young people, or adults in their thirties/early forties.
- Images used in flyers/on facebook posts
- How to get around the image of an 'older persons' sport which any observers of an event would see.
- Can we set a target of how many new members we want to recruit
- Technical aspects of publicity, such as boosting posts, target audience and timing of posts.
- Score events or those that use two or three short courses that encourage discussion and social interaction at the event
- · Team events and prizes.
- The use of non participating members to take part in the social aspects of encouraging and retaining new members.
- The use of email vs letters to communicate to the membership. It was agreed to feedback to the membership at the AGM on the results of the survey to get their thoughts.

A list of inactive members is to be drawn up so we can contact them via letter before the next round of BOF renewals.

It was decided a separate meeting was needed to discuss how to move forward with this, probably nearer Christmas.

b) Equipment Store

There has been no news on the likelihood of having to vacate the garage soon. We will look into self storage units which are located in the middle of the county to enable better access for all members. This may need multiple keys around the county.

c) East Midlands Training Day

This is to be held on Saturday 24th November at Loughborough. Courses for planners, controllers, organisers and mappers are on offer. PO has made a list of possible participants who currently don't have the qualifications.

Committee members will approach these people to offer them a place.

d) Committee Nominations

The posts of Chairman and Fixtures Secretary/Volunteer Co-ordinator are overdue to be changed at the next AGM. The Treasurers post is also up for renewal this year. AB has contacted possible candidates but no volunteers have come forward. The posts will be advertised as vacant for the AGM.
