2 Items for Discussion

a) AGM Feedback

It was agreed that the venue and food were excellent and good value for money. Bassetlaw Hub Club accounts have not been included in the club figures for several years. PO to follow this up to clarify the figure to include in the accounts and what will happen to the funds if the group is discontinued.

b) UK Elite League

DS has been contacted by Duncan Birtwistle, UK Elite Orienteering League Co-ordinator to see if we can host a sprint race on Saturday 25th April for the Elite squad. DS has agreed to be planner and has identified Top Valley as a possible venue. This was agreed and a possible Organiser and Controller were also identified.

c) Condes Upgrade

SE has asked for the Condes upgrade as the present one will not recognise the latest editions of OCAD. The same licensing arrangements as for the current version will apply and updates for three years. The cost is in the region of £250. This was agreed.

d) Financial Incentives for Mappers

After the discussion at a previous meeting we agreed for the mapper of the Retford map to be paid £100 plus 60p for each competitor as a pilot. This was to test out the feasibility of a system of reward for the mappers who spend a lot time producing our maps. SE has been working out possible ways for this to work in the future. After discussion it was agreed that a one off payment for a new map based on the area mapped would be the best approach with a separate rate for updates. Also different rates for urban and forest maps. Further work will be done to finalise details and brought to the next meeting.

f) Club Captain Report

The option of a West Midlands venue or East Anglia for the Compass Sport Trophy was discussed. It was agreed that a coach would be a good idea especially for the club atmosphere it provides.

4 Any Other Business

PO asked for ideas for the volunteer gifts for this year. The suggestion of a sit mat was well received.

PC has had a request for funding from our elite athlete which was agreed by the committee.

JW attended the Club and Members Forum in Leeds in November and was disappointed with the day. He reported that BOF were looking at the membership fees and the 'problem' of people joining later in the year but before November 1st were not getting a full years membership for their money. This will be put to the membership at the next AGM to see if we change to a pro rata rate, have an annual membership from our original joining date or keep the current system.
