2 a) Club Development

VK has been working on ways to encourage newcomers. The event at Gedling was not very successful due to the awful weather. The event at the University attracted more people and the newcomers have all been followed up. VK has produced a report on how people are responding to facebook posts and then following up by going to the newcomers part of the website.

Newark and Sherwood have approved a grant for permanent orienteering courses. There are three in the pipeline with Ollerton Pit Wood having the posts put in on Wednesday.

AS is planning to put on a 'try orienteering' for members of Holme Pierrepont running club during the summer. If this is successful this may be rolled out to other running clubs who have members from NOC.

At the Shireoaks event a local family took part but despite some coaching before they started they failed to punch the finish. We need to have enough volunteers so we can explain how things work for newcomers. The team for Explore the Parks were well rehearsed on how to introduce people to the sport and this needs to be passed on to other volunteers.

Other ideas to encourage people to enter would be keeping the entries open longer than 30 minutes after the first start and having notices at venues before the event to publicise it. This would involve more manpower and increased travel before the event. VK is also developing new visual templates to make our publicity more attractive to prospective participants.

b) Coaching: Couch to Green Plans

Following the online Development Conference organised by BOF, specifically the club development officer approach, we are looking into the possibility of putting on two blocks of weekly 'events' for four weeks with some online activities in between. It is hoped that the format used by CLOK will be shared via BOF to avoid 'recreating the wheel'

c) Environmental Impact of Events

We can make a start on this by having information on public transport to events on all pre event information. DC agreed to find this information and add it to the 'information for organisers' that is sent out for each event.

d) Non Renewals

Reminders were sent to members who have not renewed. A positive response has been for some members which leaves 14 outstanding. Some of these we are aware are not renewing, some are recent joiners. JB agreed to follow up a couple of outstanding lapsed members.
